

#### INTERLUDE: WHY DID THIS MEME SUCCEED? (A)

NEW CULTURAL ARTIFACTS -GONGG, IMAGES, SLOGANS, ETC. - GET CREATED AND INTRODUCED INTO THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM EVERY DAY. MOST OF THEM ASPIRE TO MEME STATUS YET MANY ARE CALLED, BUT FEW ARE CHOSEN.



THERE'S NO FORMULA. THE PROCESS IS UNPREDICTABLE AT BEST. MUCH DEPENDS ON LUCK — GOOD OR BAD LUCK, DEPENDING ON WHETHER YOU'RE THE CREATOR OF THE MEME OR THE SUBJECT, WILLING OR (LIKE PIKE) UNWILLING.
